Glossary of Terms

Cover Photo – Your cover photo is the large picture at the top of your timeline, above your profile picture.

Follow – Follow is a way to hear from people you're interested in, even if you're not friends. The Follow button is also a way to fine-tune your News Feed to get the types of updates you want to see.

Friend – Friends are people you connect and share with on Facebook.

Groups – Groups are close circles of people that share and keep in touch on Facebook.

Like – Clicking Like is a way to give positive feedback and connect with things you care about.

Messages – Your messages and messages inbox house your ongoing conversations with people on Facebook.

News Feed – Your News Feed is an ongoing list of updates on your homepage that shows you what's new with the friends and pages you follow.

Profile – On Facebook, your profile is your timeline.

Profile Picture – Your profile picture is the main photo of you on your timeline. Your profile picture appears as a thumbnail next to your comments and other activity on Facebook.

Tagging – A tag links a person, page, or place to something you post, like a status update or a photo. For example, you can tag a photo to say who's in the photo or post a status update and say who you're with.

Ticker – On the right side of your home page, lets you see all your friends' activity in real time.

Timeline – Your timeline is your collection of the photos, stories and experiences that tell your story.

Wall – Your Wall is the space on your timeline where you and friends can post and share.
