

## ***Chagall for Children Components***

Each work of art also includes a unique interactive that expands on the style, form, color or whimsy of the piece.

### **America Windows**

Visitors explore effects of light on stained glass by recreating a Chagall window.

### **The Circus**

Don a camouflage cape and insert yourself into the painting through the magic of video

### **The Rooster**

Attach Velcro feathers to a soft sculpture copy of the painting

### **The Poultry Yard**

Create fantastic 3-D soft sculpture animals by connecting heads, bodies, legs, wings, fins, and tails

### **The Green Violinist**

Take a digital snapshot of your face and change the color to green, purple or blue. What is your mood when you change the colors?

### **Paris Through the Window**

An incomplete painting needs to be finished by adding magnetic pieces (a cat, a train, a building)

### **The Birthday**

Make and take a bas-relief rubbing of this painting.

### **The Blue House**

Use Lincoln Logs to create a 3-D version of Chagall's Blue House

### **The Concert**

Push buttons to introduce different instruments into a symphony. Pick and choose which sounds you want to hear.

### **The Flying Sleigh**

Touch the screen and change the details of the painting (i.e. replace the chicken with a goat/fish creature, change the baby to a violin, change the building to a giant clock). Make up a story about the new painting.

### **The Juggler**

Touch the screen and animate small portions of the painting.

### **Flowers**

Push buttons to smell the different types of flowers, and arrange artificial flowers into bouquets

### **I and the Village**

Reconstruct the painting by putting pieces of a puzzle together

### **Job Tapestry**

A vertical loom allows kids to weave pieces of fabric and yarn.

### **Four Seasons**

A reproduction of the giant mosaic piece that can be seen at the First National Bank Plaza in Chicago on Dearborn. Here, it has been styled into benches for adults to rest on.

### **Reading Shelf**

A collection of books on Chagall for children and adults to peruse and read.
