

# ENTRY FORM + RELEASE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES + RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- The 17th Annual Teen Film Fest competition will be held from 7-9 p.m. on Friday, August 18, 2023 in the Hendrickson Room of the Arlington Heights Memorial Library. The director/filmmaker must be present at the fest to win.
- · Deadline for submissions is Friday, July 21, 3023.
- Films should be no longer than six minutes in length.
- Only three films are allowed per person. A completed entry form MUST be submitted for EACH film submitted to the fest.
- All projects should be made into YouTube videos on the director's YouTube account. You must allow for embedding of the videos on your YouTube account. We can't wait to watch your films!
- · Please email your films as YouTube links to: teens@ahml.info.
- Filmmakers must be 12 to 18 years of age. Adults may appear in the film, but should have no other responsibilities in the production of the film.
- In the case of a high number of submissions, we may not be able to show all of the films submitted to the fest. We will notify you if your film will be screened at the film fest.

## RELEASE

The applicant, in entering the A.H. Teen Film Fest, agrees to all rules and regulations defined in the Official Festival Rules and agrees to allow the A.H. Teen Film Fest to:

- A. Show the work to a nonpaying public on the night of the A.H. Teen Film Festival.
- B. Use the work for not-for-profit A.H. Teen Film Fest promotions and fundraising.
- C. Include or embody the work in another film produced by the A.H. Teen Film Fest such as a collection of films, to be used for promotion of the A.H. Teen Film Fest (not for profit).
- D. Display the work, in part or in its entirety, on the fest organizer company's websites.
- E. Present the work to the public by any means including the internet, cable, satellite, radio, television, newspapers and DVD.
- F. Have the entry listed in our catalog of entries.

By signing below, Applicant understands, agrees, represents and acknowledges that:

- 1. Applicant is the creator of their entry into the A.H. Teen Film Fest and adheres to the library's Patron-Generated Content Policy.
- 2. Applicant holds all necessary intellectual property rights to submit said entry into the A.H. Teen Film Fest.
