## **Nominations: How Does It Work?**

The board of the Friends of the AHML isn't always the same people - board members run for re-election every two years and may serve only two terms before changing positions. How are new board members selected?

In January, a committee is formed to review the open positions and collect nominations. The committee includes both board and non-board FOL members. In March, the board will approve the slate of candidates. Paper and electronic ballots are prepared and sent to the membership.



The election is held at the Annual Membership meeting in April, with both paper and electronic ballots counted. The board president may also make appointments to open committee positions. The newly elected board members and committee chairs are seated at the May board meeting.








### Cash vs. Credit

The Friends began accepting credit cards at their book sales in August of 2022. At that sale, credit cards accounted for 36% of the total sales.

Since that time, credit card sales have varied at each sale but the average has increased to 43%. Cash sales still account for the majority (51% of total sales) with checks and PayPal accounting for the remaining 6%.

### **FOL Children's Winter Book Sale**

The Friends of the Arlington Heights Memorial Library will host the Children's Winter Book Sale on February 1 and 2, 2025. There is no Adult sale in February.

Friday January 31: 6 pm - 8 pm Members' Night (Membership required)

Saturday February 1: 9 am – 4 pm Children's Sale Sunday February 2: Noon - 3 pm Bag Sale, \$8 / bag

The Children's sale is held in the Cardinal Room on the 1st floor near the Dunton Avenue entrance. The Children's sale will feature kids and teen fiction, nonfiction books, EZ readers, board books, DVD movies, audiobooks and music CDs for children, puzzles and games. Most books are 50 cents, and most AV materials are \$1, or as priced.

There will be a 25% teacher discount for teachers with a valid ID on Friday and Saturday. There will be an \$8 bag sale for regular Children's sale items on Sunday (no teacher discount).

#### Outside the Cardinal Room, Friday and Saturday:

- There will be a selection of \$1 Adult Fiction and Nonfiction.
- There will be a selection of DVDs and Blu-Rays, \$1 each,
  7 for \$5, 15 for \$10
- There will be 10 cent paperbacks

The Friends Used Book Shop, near the stairs, has books, movies and music for adults and children. The Shop is open every day; most kids books are 50 cents and most adult books are \$1.

#### Friday Members' Night:
