### Last Chance to Apply for Manufacturing Grant through IMEC

The Illinois Manufacturing Excellence Center (IMEC) recently announced their 2025 "Made in Illinois Grant Program." This program can help small and mid-sized manufacturers by providing up to \$50,000 in matching funds for certain expenditures.

Qualifying businesses must be manufacturers with NAICS codes 31-33, employ between 5 and 250 employees, have operated in Illinois for at least three years,



and recorded sales tax revenue in the last 12 months. Applications will be accepted April 15-30, 2025.
